



INSTITUTE OF TRANSPORTATION ENGINEERS COLORADO AND WYOMING SECTION 2018 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION PACKET

In order to encourage undergraduate and graduate level students pursuing careers in the transportation-related fields, the ITE CO/WY section is providing the following scholarship opportunities on a yearly basis:

- The ITE CO/WY Undergraduate Level Scholarship – (\$1,500 - \$2,000) per applicant
- The ITE CO/WY Graduate Level Scholarship – (\$2,000 - \$2,500) per applicant
- The ITE CO/WY Executive Committee Leadership Award (Undergrad or Grad Students) – (\$700 - \$1,000) per applicant

Scholarship awards will be distributed on an annual basis until funds are depleted, the scholarship award will be given in the student's name, and the student at their discretion will use the award amount.

Application Eligibility:

- Be a member of the ITE CO/WY Section or a registered university student chapter of ITE (refer to www.ite.org for national membership information or go to www.cowyite.org for section membership information. For students, the **first year of membership is free**, and additional discounts for returning students may be available. For more information, go to www.ite.org and refer to the Student Membership Offer under the Membership page.)
- Be enrolled (part-time or full-time) in either an undergraduate or graduate (Masters or PhD) degree level program pursuing a career in a transportation-related field at a university within Colorado or Wyoming. Example programs include but are not necessarily limited to civil engineering, transportation engineering, mechanical engineering, planning, economics, construction management, data analytics, and public health/behavioral science.
- Demonstrate an interest in the transportation engineering/planning/construction industry.
- Submit a complete application by the deadline.

Note: If previously awarded an ITE CO/WY Section scholarship within the last 3 years, preference will be given to new applicants.
